
The Nature Preserve is dedicated to protecting wildlife and natural habitats.



Wetlands Park



NO BIKES in the Nature Preserve. **Bikes** allowed ONLY on Wetlands Loop Trail, Sunrise Trail, Duck Creek Trails, and unpaved trails outside the Nature Preserve.



NO DOGS in the Nature Preserve. **Leashed dogs allowed ONLY** on Wetlands Loop Trail, Duck Creek trails and all other trailheads. Service animals welcome.

SHARE the Park, RESPECT Others, PRESERVE Wildlife



Bikes ALLOWED on all trails EXCEPT in the Nature Preserve.



Leashed dogs ALLOWED on all trails EXCEPT in the *Nature Preserve*.



Horses ALLOWED on UNPAVED trails. NO HORSES in the Nature Preserve.
